3 . USING A 6MM ALLEN WRENCH TIGHTEN THE BOLTS AND THEN INSTALL THE OTHER MOUNT ON THE RIGHT SIDE.						
4 . TAKE A MINI LIGHT OUT OF THE PACKAGING AND USING A 2MM ALLEN WRENCH ONE AT A TIME REMOVE EACH SET SCREW AND APPLY A SMALL DROP OF REMOVABLE THREAD LOCK. REINSTALL THE SET SCREW AND CLEAN OFF ANY EXCESS THREAD LOCK. REPEAT THIS FOR THE OTHER MINI LIGHT. SEE FIG. 2 .
